Questions of Nominee Hagel Should Focus on Defense, Not LGBT Left Intimidation

The following comments on the nomination of former Nebraska Senator **Chuck Hagel** to be Secretary of Defense may be attributed to CMR President **Elaine Donnelly**:

Defense Secretary nominee **Chuck Hagel** is catching heat for being one of several senators who questioned former **President Bill Clinton's** 1998 nomination of **LGBT** (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender) activist James C. Hormel to be ambassador to **Luxembourg**.

When confirmation hearings begin, members of the Senate should ask the contrarian Republican tough questions about his views on **Afghanistan**, **Iran**, **Israel**, **Africa**, **China**, and **Korea**. We need to know what he would do to maintain superiority in America's armed forces.

But for reasons explained in this article, senators should not buy into the complaints of intolerant gay activist leaders who are demanding full rainbow-spectrum implementation of LGBT law in our military:
